This 25-month, ADA-CODA accredited program is a hybrid blend of both hospital- and dental school-based training. The program emphasizes orthograde and surgical clinical endodontics to build diagnostic experience, re-treatment assessment, and to develop skills for treating patients under sedation or in the operating room.

Endodontics At-A-Glance

- Comprehensive didactic curriculum to complement clinical experiences.
- Two training locations: Family Health Centers at NYU Langone Hospital–Brooklyn, NY or University of Puerto Rico School of Dental Medicine.
- Residents can expect to conduct a variety of procedures, working with specialists in orthodontics, pediatric dentistry, prosthodontics, oral surgery, oral pathology, endodontics, orofacial pain and periodontics on a diverse patient population, including those with special needs.
- The program encourages the use of state-of-the-art technologies, including surgical operating microscopes, digital radiography, cone beam computed tomography and ultrasonics.
- Successful completion of the program grants a certificate in endodontics and meets the eligibility requirements for the American Board of Endodontics examination.
- Attractive and competitive stipend as well as comprehensive fringe benefits are offered.
